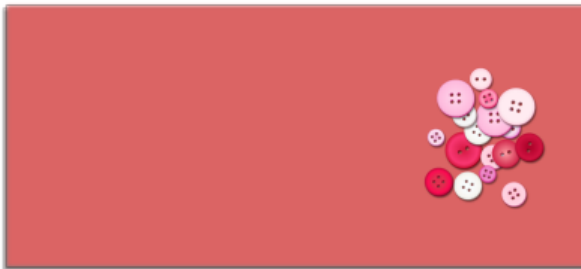


Fabric Felt Notebook

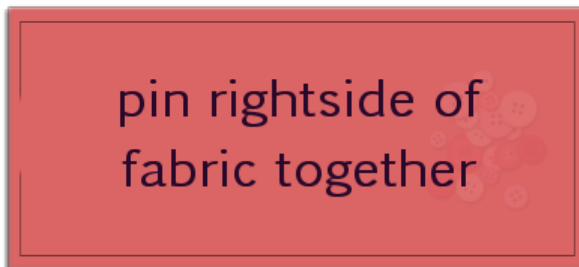
1. Cut your choice of fabric and felt - 12.75 inches by 6.5 inches. (variations: felt/felt or fabric/fabric)



2. Add embellishments to the right side of your fabric (sew beading, add notions, or felt).

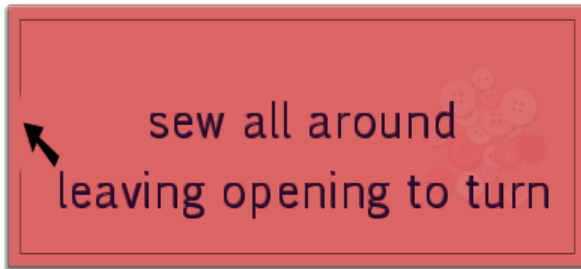


3. Once embellishments are completed, iron your fabric and place right side down on felt. Pin all the way around leaving a 1.5 to 2 inch unpinned opening to turn once fabric is sewn- use ¼ inch to ½ seam allowance.



4. Felt/Felt-variation instructions: Pin fabric with embellishment side up, do a simple blanket stitch or stitch using sewing machine (use ¼ inch to ½ seam allowance) all the way around. Remember felt does not fray.
5. Sew all sides, except for opening. Sew using straight stitch with ¼ inch to ½ seam allowance.

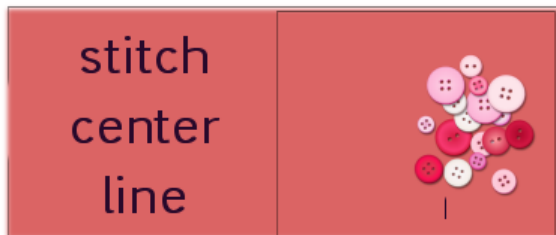

6. Turn fabric inside out and fix corners.
7. Iron fabric flat.
8. Turn fabric inside and stitch opening close.



9. Fold finish piece in half, iron again with heavy starch.
10. Using center "iron" line stitch another straight stitch all the way down- this creates the "center binding line" for you notebook.



11. Cut your paper.
12. Prepare your paper using the 5 stitch bookbinding technique.
13. Glue or stitch fabric to paper.
