

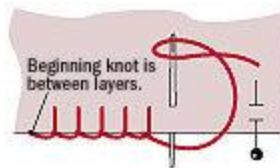
How to sew a blanket stitch

The blanket stitch is a decorative hand-stitch usually worked around the fabric outer edges.

- Turn under the fabric edges the depth of the desired stitches and pin.
- Knot the thread end and insert the needle between the fabric layers through the edge at the starting point. Work from left to right with the folded edge toward you (Figure 1).

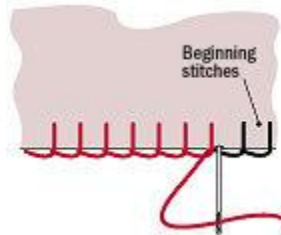
Work left to right.



- After the last stitch, push the needle back through the edge just past the final stitch (Figure 2).

Insert needle just past last stitch.



- Secure the work by taking several backstitches inside the fold
